An extended quota applies to New Zealand competitors.

ENTRIES: All entries to be on standard FIS entry forms.
Separate forms for male and female competitors.
Entries for foreign competitors must come through their National Association and should be submitted by the Team

Complimentary lift passes will be issued to all National Team members with fewer than 50 FIS points and coaches listed on the race entry form to a limit of 1 pass per team per 8 athletes or part thereof.
