An extended quota applies to New Zealand competitors.

ENTRIES: All entries to be on standard FIS entry forms.
Separate forms for male and female competitors.
Entries for foreign competitors must come through their National Association and should be submitted by the Team Captain of each team. Entries must reach the Race Secretary by 12 noon Friday 12th August 2005.
