

AUSTRALIA NEW ZEALAND CONTINENTAL CUP (ANC)

RULES: Rules for the Alpine FIS Continental Cup 2010/2011 apply.

ELIGIBILITY: Refer Continental Cup Rules 2010/11 Section B Rule ANC 2.3.

Higher Quotas for ANC Events: Australia may enter up to 30 competitors (30 men and ladies). New Zealand as the organising nation may enter 50 competitors; in addition they are entitled to any of the 30 places Australia does not fill. Competitors from Australia, New Zealand and the African Continent can compete even if they do not have FIS points but they must have a FIS code. See rules ANC.2.3.1 and 2.3.4

FIS Quotas for Visiting Nations: New Zealand has the right to allow a nation from other regions up to double their normal FIS quota provided that all competitors appear on the valid FIS list and have a maximum of 140 FIS points in SL and GS and 160 FIS points in SG qualifying through DH, SG or GS. See rule ANC 2.3.3.

Double FIS quotas for visiting nations: The ROC has the right to allow a nation from other regions up to double their normal FIS quota. **Quota requests must be received directly from the National Association 10 days prior to the start of competition. The decision on quotas will be made 5 days prior to the event.** All competitors must appear on valid FIS list and have maximum FIS points as specified.

ENTRY: All entries must be made through the National Ski Racing Organisation. Entry must be made on the official FIS entry form, with separate forms for male and female competitors.

ENTRIES CLOSE AT 3 PM ON SUNDAY 29th AUGUST, 2010.

ENTRIES WITH QUOTA REQUESTS CLOSE 3PM, MONDAY 23rd AUGUST, 2010.

REFUNDS: A 50% refund of the first races entry fee will be given if the event is cancelled. A 100% refund of consecutive entry fees will be given if subsequent races are cancelled.
