You are required within 5 working days of the date of this Notice of Complaint required to complete the Notice of Defence (Form 2) stating whether:

- (a) you wish to defend the charge(s) of misconduct and if so you are required to outline the evidence you propose to provide in support of your defence, or
- (b) you admit the charge(s) of misconduct and waive your right to appear at the hearing, or
- (c) you admit the charge(s) of misconduct but still wish to participate at the hearing as to penalty.

If you do not file the Notice of Defence within 5 working days of the date of this Notice the Judicial Committee may hear and determine the Complaint of Misconduct in your absence including imposing a penalty on you if you are found to have committed the alleged misconduct.

You should read the enclosed Rules of the Judicial Committee of SRNZ carefully. These are enclosed in order that you understand your rights and obligations. You are entitled to seek advice on this matter and to be represented by a person of your choice. If you have any questions regarding this you may contact the office of Ski Racing New Zealand.
