RULES

ANC FIS rules will apply to all competitions

ELIGIBILITY

1. Basic Quota: Each Nation is entitled to a basic quota of 2 on the condition that competitors have maximum of 120 FIS points in any of the four Disciplines
2. National Quota: Each National Association's additional quota for entry will be determined by the number of competitors ranked in the top 100 in either Slalom or GS on the July 2002 Points List. National Quotas apply as per Rule 2.2, Section A Continental Cup Rules 2000/2001
3. Australia may enter up to 30 Men and 30 Women
4. New Zealand may enter a basic quota of 50 Men ~~and 50~~ and 50 Women and may also take up any of the 30 Men and 30 Women places allocated to Australia which are not used.

All entries on standard FIS entry forms. All entries must be received by Monday 19 August 2002. Late entries may be considered by the Organising Committee, penalties may be incurred.

RACE HEADQUARTERS

Race Headquarters will be situated in Lorenz's Bar and Café at the Top O' the Bruce at Whakapapa. This will open at 7.00am until 8.30am for ticket issue, official start lists and general information. The Race Office for results tabulation will be at the Creche office at Whakapapa. The Officials Room will be situated at the Knoll Ridge Café Function Room Level 2 Knoll Ridge Chalet at Whakapapa. The Official Notice Board will be situated outside the Knoll Ridge Function Room Level 2 Knoll Ridge Chalet at Whakapapa.

BIB and LIFT PASS ISSUE

1. Bibs and Lift Passes for Competitors and Coaches will be at the Teams Captain's Meetings
2. Lift Passes for Officials will be issued from the Race Headquarters as above
3. All competitors will be eligible for 50% concession as follows = Adults \$27 and Youth \$14
5 Day consecutive pass = Adults \$95 and Youth \$48
4. Competitors eligible for complimentary lift tickets are as follows: Refer to Rule ANC.2.4.2 and ANC.2.4.2.1, Section B, Continental Cup Rules 2000/2001
5. Coaches will receive complimentary lift passes on a 1 coach per 5 athletes basis
6. All Race Officials and Course Judges receive on complimentary pass if required for use on the race day and one complimentary pass per day worked.

1. \$40 per race.
