ELIGIBILITY: Conditions of entry as per FIS International Competition Rules including: -
Competitors must hold a current FIS Licence.
Each nation is entitled to a basic quota of two provided competitors have a maximum of 140 FIS points.
Other than basic quota any competitor must be ranked in the top 1000 on the valid FIS points list.
These quotas do not apply to New Zealand or Australian competitors.

ENTRIES: All entries to be on standard FIS entry forms.
Separate forms for male and female competitors.
All entries to be submitted by the Team Captain of each team.
Entries must reach the Race Secretary by 5pm Wednesday 31st July 2002
